Prime Minister Adams has asked me to forward the following message to you:

Begins:


"I wish to extend on behalf of the Government and people of Barbados our deepest sympathy to those whose relatives and friends made the supreme sacrifice in the struggle in the South Atlantic which has now culminated in recovery of the Falkland Islands.

We believe as always that the creation of a stable international community lies in adherence to certain principles including the right of self-determination and the peaceful settlement of disputes. Only adherence to such principles can protect small and vulnerable societies.

For the future, we trust that a solution will be found which will bind up the wounds inflicted during the last ten weeks. We also hope that the outcome will discourage aggression in the conduct of international affairs."
