It reads: 'Gibraltar rejoices in your victory over aggression and offers you its warmest congratulations on your unwavering and successful defence of freedom, human rights and self-determination'. The Foreign and Commonwealth Secretary thinks it would be appropriate to send a short message in reply which could refer to Gibraltar's support for Britain throughout the crisis.
