CABINET: 26 JUNE

We have a difficulty over Cabinet on 26 June because of the time you need to leave for the European Council at The Hague that day.

You need to be there for Queen Beatrix's lunch. We had thought this would allow there to be an early Cabinet at 0900, and for you still to get to The Hague in time. There seems no reason why we should not push those an hour forward, and this would provide a two hour slot for Cabinet from 0900 to 1100.
