**MOTION FOR ERM DEBATE 23 OCTOBER**

Below is the motion which the Chancellor has agreed for tomorrow's debate. This has also been agreed with the Prime Minister's and Lord President's offices.

"This House congratulates the Government on joining the ERM of the EMS. The House notes the clear evidence that the Government's tight monetary and fiscal policies are reducing inflationary pressures in the economy; and believes ERM membership will reinforce the Government's counter-inflationary strategy and help to strengthen the framework for a sustained improvement in economic performance."

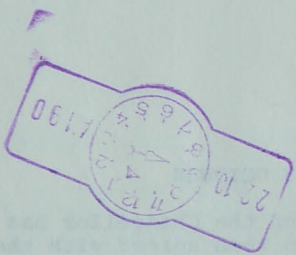
